Where people visiting Columbus, Ohio stay!

Gasoline prices have altered everything we do from shopping to travel. Vacation time is important as a means to relieve stress and recharge for the challenges ahead but the cost of travel has created havok with family budgets.

Many vacationers are looking at what is available closer to home this year and many are finding Central Ohio has much to offer. That's where Grove City enters the picture.

Grove City has a significant investment in the tourism market and has positioned itself well as one of the best overnight destinations in Central Ohio.

The city has 12 nationally branded hotels located at I-71 South at Exit 100 Stringtown Road. The exit provides easy access and is just six miles from Downtown Columbus.

The most distant attraction, the Columbus Zoo, is only a short 25 minute drive.

Why Grove City and Exit 100?

Within a mile of the exit there are 52 places to dine and well over 100 eateries throughout Grove City; there's great shopping too!

Many activities close to the hotel area include a paved walking trail, 11,000 square foot skate park, city outdoor aquatic center, miniature golf, batting cages, award winning children's play area and 10 unique herb gardens at the Gardens at Gantz Farm.

The Grove City Welcome Center and Museum, 3378 Park St., is open daily from 8:30 am until 4:30 pm with local information available 24/7 at both entrances to the building. The museum features at 1912 Ford Model T in mint condition.

In Columbus, take advantage of unique shopping in the Short North, shows and special entertainment in the Arena District and at the Ohio, Palace and Southern Theatres. There's also the

Columbus Zoo and Zoombezi Bay water park, Center of Science and Industry (COSI), Franklin Park Conservatory and much more.



Grove City Welcome Center and Museum in the Town Center just two miles from Exit 100.



Grove City's Big Splash Aquatic Center has been a popular destination for locals as well as out-of-town visitors. The pool offers two 190-foot water slides, an exceptional play area for younger children that includes a climbing wall. The pool is about five minutes from the hotel area. Opens Memorial Day weekend.
