Air Show Features Model Jet Aircraft In September

The 2010 E-Jet International model airplane air show will be four days of flying Sept. 9-12 at the Field of Dreams Airport in Grove City.

Some of these jets are as large as 8-12 feet and are built to scale of the larger jet aircraft.

Competitors from a range of foreign countries including Canada, England, Germany, Austria and Russia will be in the city to compete in a wide range of aerial maneuvers.

Many pilots will be attempting to break last year's speed record of 193 mph set by Pilot Rob Lynch.

The 2010 Arts in the Alley opens Saturday, Sept. 18 with the annual parade starting at Broadway and Southwest Boulevard at 9:30 a.m. Festivities in the Town Center begin at 10 a.m. and continue through 8 p.m. The two-day event wraps up Sunday from 11 a.m. until 5 p.m.



Its two-days of continuous entertainment from two stages with a wide range of music that includes blues, soul, pop rock, swing, jazz, gospel, bluegrass, country and children's karaoke. Show awards will be presented at 3 p.m. at the Heartland stage. Awards to be announced include the Grove City Easel Award, Helena McComb Award, all First Place winners, Best of Show and People's Choice winners in all classes.
